	The PhD project aims to analyse the trade relations between Armenia and Central and East Asia between the 7th and 14th centuries from the point of view of material culture, using the presence of imported Chinese ceramics and		

	local imitations of such ceramics as a key. The ideal candidate must have experience in the archaeology of medieval ceramic production, including in the Middle East, and in archaeological stratigraphy proven by participation in research projects, both national and international, and by scientific publications. He/she will also have to demonstrate in-depth knowledge and proven field research experience based on the methods of light archaeology, historical archaeology, spatial analysis, stratigraphic analysis of elevations, skills in the use of GIS systems and digital photogrammetry. A proven track record of archaeological research in Armenia, with a focus on medieval contexts, is also required. Knowledge of Italian and English is required (to be verified during the oral test).
