Language Requirements

Who should take the test	Non-Eu citizens residing abroad who intend to enroll in a program taught in Italian
How to take the test	<u>CLIQ quality system</u> B2 certificates in Italian (PLIDA, CELI, CILS, CERTIT) Italian L2 test provided by <u>CISIA</u> in remote (minimum passing score is 55 out of 72 points) Italian L2 test provided by the <u>University Language Center</u>
Exemption from the test	Enroll in a program taught in English
	Already hold one of the aforementioned certificates no lower than the B2 level
	Hold a certificate of a Foundation Year issued in Italian
	Hold a bachelor's degree issued in an Italian university
	Hold a high school diploma issued in an Italian school or an Italian school abroad
