The PhD student recipient of the scholarship funded by the Agency must carry out the research project in line with what is indicated in the Research Project Fact Sheet approved for the funding. 2. The PhD student recipient of the scholarship funded by the Agency must comply with the obligations related to intellectual property aspects as outlined in the following Article 5. Article 5 (Intellectual property and research results) 1. Universities may not use, for advertising purposes or any other promotional activity, the name, trademark, or other distinctive sign of the Agency except to disclose the funding of the PhD scholarships. 2. Without prejudice to the moral right of authorship of the PhD students, the ownership of the research results of the projects funded by the Agency will be shared equally (50%) between the Agency and the University. Consequently, the University will promptly inform the Agency – via Certified Electronic Mail (PEC) to the address acn@pec.acn.gov.it – of the existence of research results so that the Agency, within the following sixty days, may express its possible intention to waive its right via Certified Electronic Mail (PEC) to the address acn@pec.acn.gov.it. In such a case, the University will acquire full ownership of the research results. Article 9 (Revocations, non-allocation of scholarships, withdrawals, terminations, and cessations) 1. The Agency will proceed with the total revocation of the funding, with the consequent obligation for the University to return any amounts already disbursed, in the following cases: a) failure to start the doctoral program in the XLI doctoral cycle within the established deadlines; b) interruption of the courses due to reasons attributable to the University as outlined in the Call and the Implementation Regulations; d) implementation of the research project in a manner different from that approved for funding. 2. RESEARCH PROJECT	The research project (between 10.000 and 15.000 characters, within spaces, notes and bibliographical references), drafted in Italian, English or French, shall fit within one of the curricula (that must be identified in the application). The project must specify the topic of the research, clarify the characteristics of originality, briefly indicate the state of the art on the subject (with appropriate bibliographical references) and the lines of investigation that can be usefully develop over the three years of the PhD program. The candidate may apply for several rankings by attaching for each one a separate project consistent with the thematic chosen clearly indicating the reference to it.				
FURTHER INFORMATION ON THE INTERVIEW	The oral test consists of an interview focusing on knowledge of the curricular subject matter derived from the written test and the discussion of a line of research proposed by the candidate. The test may be conducted in Italian or English.
