- to hold a qualification obtained abroad which has been officially recognised as equivalent by the competent authorities, or, alternatively, to attach the relevant documentation for evaluation by the Selection Committee for the sole purpose of this selection procedure;
- to be the main author, or an author without the participation of the doctoral



supervisor, of the following scientific publication:

- to undertake to submit, in the event of selection, a project proposal as Principal Investigator under the European Research Council (ERC), Starting Grant funding scheme, designating the University of Florence as Host Institution;
- not to be subject to any submission restrictions for the ERC Starting Grant 2028 call;
- to acknowledge that, in the event of a positive evaluation of the proposal, the contractual relationship and its management shall be governed by the University Regulations on Post-Doctoral Appointments (*Incarichi post-Doc*) pursuant to Article 22-bis of Law No. 240/2010, as adopted by Rector's Decree No. 1342/2025;
- not to have previously held fixed-term researcher positions pursuant to Article 24 of Law No. 240/2010;
- not to hold a permanent position at a university or public research organization;
- to be aware of, and to comply with, the other rules on incompatibility and accumulation of positions as set out in Article 5 of the University Regulations on Post-Doctoral Appointments (Rector's Decree No. 1342/2025);
- not to have been dismissed, removed or discharged from public employment for persistent insufficient performance, nor declared unfit for public service pursuant to Article 127(d) of Presidential Decree No. 3 of 10 January 1957, nor dismissed for disciplinary reasons;
- not to have any family or affinity relationship up to the fourth degree inclusive with a professor belonging to the host Department, nor with the Rector, the Director General or any member of the University's Board of Directors;
- to enjoy full civil and political rights;
- not to have been convicted of criminal offences in Italy or abroad, nor to be subject to preventive measures, civil judgments or administrative sanctions recorded in the criminal register, or, if applicable, to declare the following:
