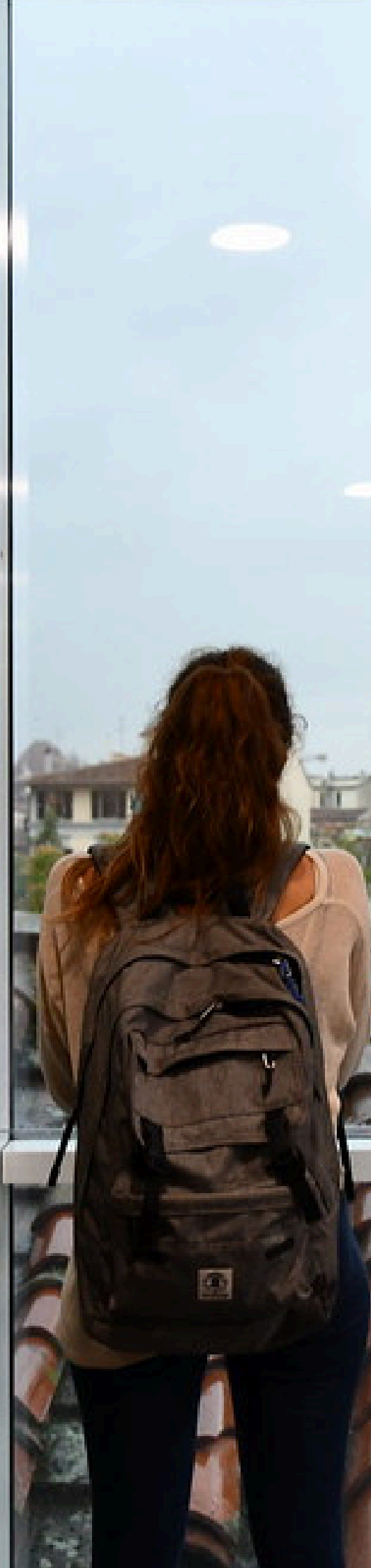

 Certified B2 English mandatory to attend courses held in English, if applicable.
 For accepted certifications please contact the relevant School coordinator.

● Deadlines



The School's International Relations Office (Unifi) must receive the nomination of the student from his/her home University (see nomination deadline). The School's International Relations Office will then get in contact with the student to proceed with the application (see application deadlines).

● If you are a non-EU student...

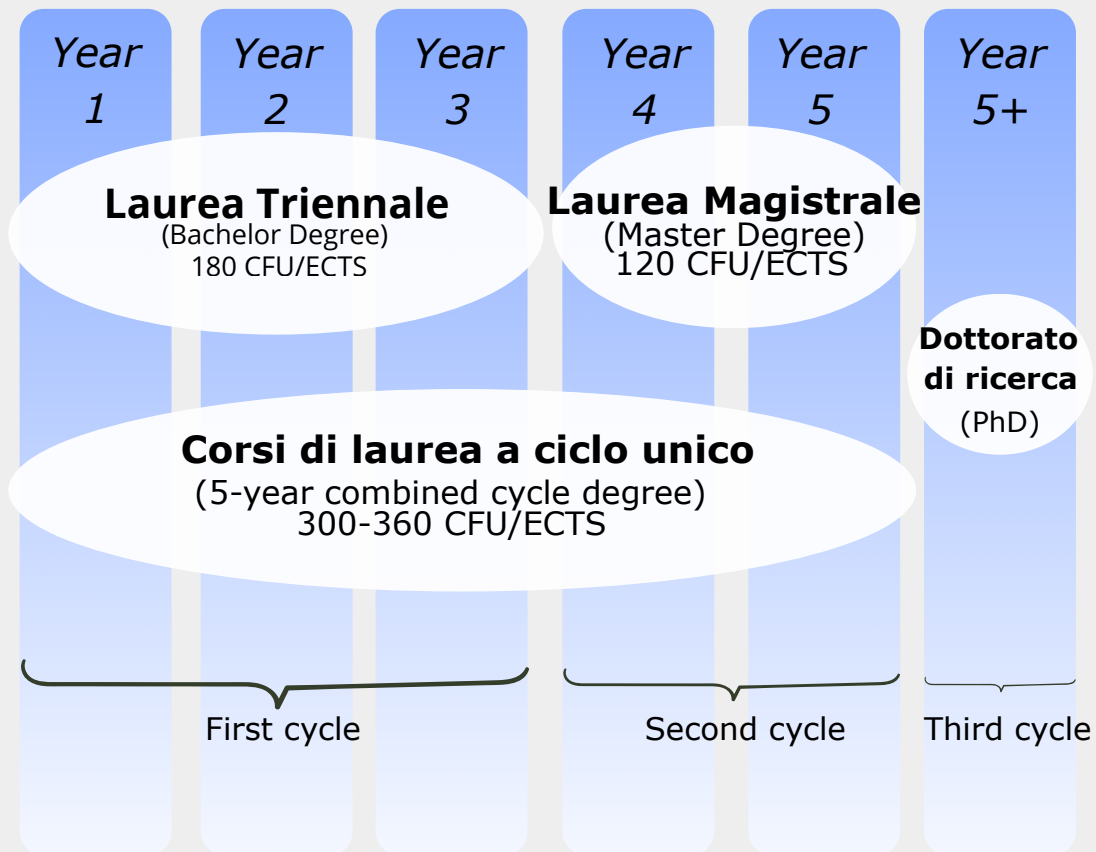
- ✓ A passport with valid entry visa for study purposes (D-Type) is needed, and a personal health insurance is strongly recommended.
 - ✓ If you already have a valid residence permit released by an EU country, you are not required to apply for an Italian residence permit up to 360 days;
 - ✓ If you do not have a valid residence permit issued by an EU country, you must apply for a residence permit within 8 days from your entry in Italy.

- ✓ It is recommended to subscribe to a private health insurance for medical assistance.
 - ✓ The International Desk provides support for the enrolment of non-EU students with a study visa.

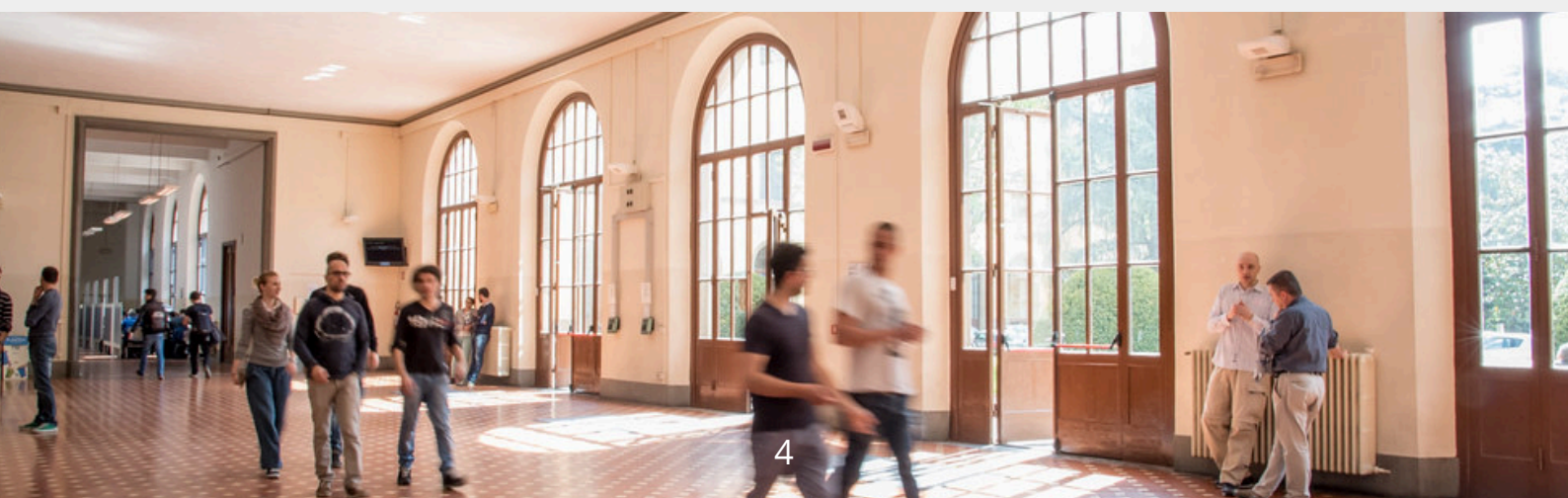




● Italian University System

The “credit” system in Italian courses is based on **university credits** (CFU) that are equivalent to ECTS credits. A full-time student conventionally undertakes an academic workload of **60 credits per year**.

Exams at the University of Florence are graded on a scale of **up to 30 points**, with 18/30 marking the minimum passing grade. Exceptional performance may be recognized with the distinction of “**cum laude**” (30 cum laude).

Taxcode (EHIC Card)

A taxcode number is necessary in order to rent a flat, open a bank account and register for the Italian health system.

To obtain the Tax Code, visit the [Revenue Agency website](#) and download the relevant **AA4/8 Form** to be filled in, or contact the International Relations office of the School in order to receive all the directions together with the UNIFI multicultural tutors.
