



Procedure for Submitting an Application for Admission by Non-EU Students Holding a Qualification Obtained Abroad

II level professional Master “Broncoscopia e Pneumologia Interventistica” (Bronchoscopy and Interventional Pulmonology) a.y. 2026/27

Non-EU citizens residing abroad who hold a qualification obtained from a foreign university (EU or non-EU), equivalent to one of the degrees accepted as an entry qualification for admission to the Master's programme (Medicine and Surgery or Dentistry and Dental Prosthetics Second Cycle Degree), must, in addition to submitting the application for admission to the Master's programme according to the procedures and within the deadlines specified in the Call for Applications, register on the University portal at:

www.universitaly.it

Registration on the University portal is a prerequisite for the issuance of a study visa by the competent Italian diplomatic missions.

At the end of the selection procedure, through the University portal, the University will notify the competent diplomatic missions of the student's acceptance or, where applicable, of the successful outcome of the admission tests, in order to allow the issuance of the study visa.

In order to facilitate the timely issuance of the study visa, applicants (non-EU students residing abroad) may complete their application on University and on the University's online application system (first phase - admission) **from 15 September 2026 to 15 October 2026**. On that date, the applications submitted will be assessed and, in the event of a positive assessment, the corresponding application on University will be validated.
