RANKING FOR SPECIFIC RESEARCH TOPICS POSITIONS ADMISSION TEST					

The interview is focused on knowledge of the curricular subject matter derived from the written test and the discussion of a line of research proposed by the candidate. The oral test consists of an interview involving the discussion of the research **INFORMATION ON THE** project submitted by the candidate and related to the subject of the call and on **INTERVIEW** the knowledge of the relevant subject matter. The test may be conducted in Italian or English. Knowledge of a foreign language to be chosen from English, French, German and Spanish is also required and of Italian language for not Italian students. The research project (between 10.000 and 15.000 characters, within spaces, notes and bibliographical references), drafted in Italian, English or French, shall fit within one of the curricula (that must be identified in the application). The project must specify the topic of the research, clarify the characteristics of **RESEARCH PROJECT** originality, briefly indicate the state of the art on the subject (with appropriate bibliographical references) and the lines of investigation that can be usefully develop over the three years of the PhD program. minimum maximum parameter score score Curriculum vitae, other qualification 15/120 25/120 documents, publications if any Research project 25/120 35/120 Applicants who obtain a mark of at least 40/120 according to the **EVALUATION MARKS** minimum score for each parameter will be admitted to the interview Interview: discussion of the research project for the assessment of the research activities to 40/120 60/120 be pursued in the three years of the doctoral course Eligibility is achieved with a minimum score of 80/120
