Practical-professional profile of the course and industry sector of reference	The course aims to deepen the knowledge of clinical pictures in the cardiac intensive care unit and related therapies. In particular, the course aims to train cardiologists, anesthesiologists, and internists who may have specific professional roles in ICU. To this end, training activities will be structured with lectures and practical exercises. At the end of the course, learners will have acquired theoretical knowledge and practical skills in cardiac intensive care to manage various clinical pictures.
