| Practical-professional profile of the course and industry sector of reference | <p>The second-level Master Course in Periodontology and Implantology is spread over three years, requires full-time attendance, and is intended for Dentists eager to have specialized knowledge and training in the field of Periodontology, Reconstructive Therapy, and Implantology. The modules include a theoretical and a practical part working on the patient. A phase of active participation in research projects is planned. The training is completed with the presentation of surgically treated clinical cases. At the end of the three years, a thesis is discussed.</p> <p>By the end of the course, learners will have acquired theoretical and scientific knowledge related to periodontal and implant therapy. They will also have acquired the specific skills and abilities to independently administer specialized treatments in periodontal and implant cases in patients.</p> |

| How the admission procedure takes place | Selection based on qualifications combined with a selective test, aimed at verifying knowledge on the anatomy of the periodontium and the stomatological apparatus; etiopathology of periodontal diseases; principles of periodontal therapy; classifications of periodontal diseases; periodontal surgery; implant surgery and peri-implant reconstructive surgery. The test will consist of an interview and a written test |
| Duration | 27 months - three years |
| Teaching methods | In-person (face-to-face teaching, pre-clinical internship, clinical internship, seminars, research activities) Distance learning only in cases where face-to-face teaching is not possible |
