<b>Practical-professional profile of the course and industry sector of reference</b>	The Master's program is dedicated exclusively to the staff of the Region of Tuscany. It aims to delve deeper into the issues of public management within the processes of innovation and digitization of public administration. In particular, starting with the indispensable elements for the definition of proper planning, programming, and control cycle, the Master course develops and identifies digital and innovative solutions for the transition to a more competent public administration that is close to the needs of its stakeholders. The course thus aims to train personnel capable of promoting within the public administration processes of innovation and digitization.
<b>Access prerequisites</b>	A bachelor's or master's degree or single-cycle degree awarded according to the system under Ministerial Decree No. 270/2004 or Ministerial Decree No. 509/1999 or previous systems.

<b>Teaching methods</b>	Face-to-face classes Participation in individual modules by remote mode only (in synchronous mode, through the Cisco Webex platform)

<b>Foreseen lecture schedule</b>	Classes will be held on Thursdays, Fridays and, every other week, also on Saturday morning.
<b>Examinations procedures and schedule</b>	The assessment of educational activities consists of examinations with a grade expressed in thirtieths and possible mention of honors held at the end of each module or subject. There will be a <i>project work</i> in lieu of the internship, to be carried out according to the student's current and possibly perspective, role in the relevant organization. The purpose is to acquire the functional skills to achieve the training objectives of the Master's professional profile. The credits provided for the practical activity are awarded to the student upon certification by the Master's Coordinator that such activity has been duly completed.
<b>Final examination</b>	The final examination consists of a written paper in summary form, which may be developed individually or in groups. It may include specific references to the experience of the project work.
