<p>Verify that the ID is valid for travel outside of your country and for the entire period of your stay in Italy</p>	<p><b>A) For stays up to 30 days:</b> No obligation by EU citizens and their hosts (free of charge hosting only) to declare their presence in Italy at the <i>Questura</i> (Police HQ)</p> <p>In case of hotel, B&amp;B or other types of paid stays the authorized hosting structure must declare all guests to the authorities via the dedicated online platform.</p> <p><b>B) For stays over 30 days:</b> Only in case the EU citizen does not have an official lease contract registered at the Revenue Agency the hosting structure must submit the relevant declaration within 48 hours of the arrival of the guest.</p>	<p>Verify that the ID is valid for travel outside of your country and for the entire period of your stay in Italy</p>	<p>1) The hosting structure or person, in case of no other official lease contract registered at the Revenue Agency, must submit the relevant declaration within 48 hours of the the arrival of the guest.</p> <p>2) Register at the <i>Anagrafe</i> (Demographic Office) of the town you reside in (it is necessary to contact the office beforehand)</p> <p><u>Documents you will need to bring:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· Valid ID card</li> <li>· Tax code</li> <li>· Work contract or proof of sufficient funds to cover living expenses (<a href="http://www.poliziadistato.it/articolo/226/">http://www.poliziadistato.it/articolo/226/</a>)</li> <li>· Health insurance</li> <li>· Any other pertinent documents</li> </ul>
